➤ ACTIONS TO DEVELOP A NATIONAL CANCER PLAN IN GREECE ◀



Short-term actions

- » Establishment of an Oncology Directorate at the Ministry of Health
- » Establishment of a Biomedical Research Department for cancer at the General Secretariat of Research and Technology
- » Implementation of a pilot Oncology-Hematology Information System at hospitals
- » Representation of patients with cancer on health policy-making committees and bodies



Mid-term actions

- » Establishment of a National Cancer Registry
- » Development of National Centers of Expertise
- » Improvement of the digital transformation of cancer health using digital technology and educating patients and carers
- » Development of a National Network of Precision Medicine in Oncology
- » Operation of the National Cancer Institute
- » Development of a National Cancer Inequalities Registry linking to the European one
- » Systematic recording of treatment protocols for better evaluation and control of good clinical practice by applying relevant international guidelines

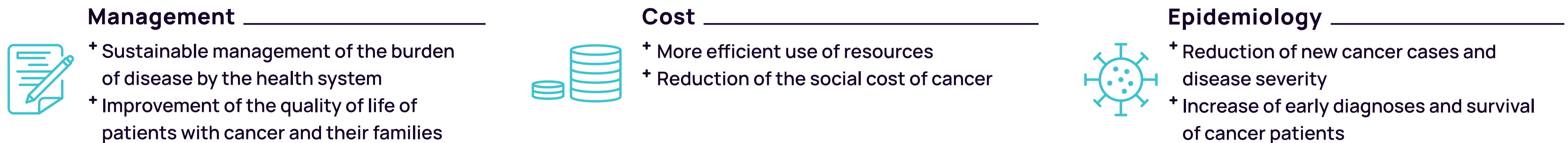
